Laptop choices:

Secondary students are required to have a laptop for their school work which can be configured by the school for the school network. While this laptop can also be used at home for leisure activities it should primarily be thought of as a device for completing schoolwork.

Older students will have probably formed a good idea about 'what works best for them'. Some will prefer a high powered PC running Windows 7 or above while others will prefer an Apple Mac. We have learnt that students are not able to complete their school work unless their laptop is of a certain standard so we have agreed on the following minimum specifications for laptops.

Those students who do not have their own device can check out a laptop from the library on a daily basis. This laptop is to be used only at school and cannot be taken home.
